This document has been compiled to provide you with the background and information to encourage you to be a bowling member of the Devonport Country Club for the 2021/22 bowls season and beyond.

BACKGROUND

The Devonport Country Club was formed by the merger of the Devonport Bowls and Croquet Club, the Devonport Golf Club and the Spreyton Bowls Club. We moved into our newly completed facility at the Devonport Country Club site, Spreyton in December 2019.

The redevelopment has enabled this new facility to possess:

- ✓ An eight rink indoor bowling centre;
- √ Three outdoor grass bowling greens;
- ✓ Two croquet lawns; and
- ✓ An updated 18-hole golf course.

With the merger of three sports clubs and a combined total of over 1,000 club members, it provides for an exciting future for these sports within the Devonport region. Along with the new sporting facilities, the redevelopment has a new clubhouse built over two levels which includes a club bar, Bistro and Function Centre.

The Bowls Section presently has over 160 active Pennant bowlers and has the following number of teams competing in the Bowls North West Pennant competitions - 5 (Saturday Open Gender), 4 (Thursday Ladies) and 2 (Men's Wednesday). Bowls Carnivals are also conducted during the summer season, with social and corporate bowls catered for as well.

The availability of an eight rink Indoor Centre allows all members to bowl all year round. Furthermore, regular day and night competitions are conducted throughout the winter (April – October) catering for all bowlers on the North West Coast.

We are actively trying to increase participation in the sport of lawn bowls and promote the Bowls Section as a pleasant and competitive environment to play the game, as well as an excellent venue to meet fellow Devonport and Coastal citizens through community activities.

RECENT PENNANT PERFORMANCE

The recently completed 2020/21 BNW Pennant bowls season was the first full bowling season for the Section conducted within its new surrounds. Our four Thursday Ladies teams and three of our five Saturday Open Gender teams made the Finals – a 77% success rate which is a great result given the fledgling nature of our Section.

These performances will allow the Section, going on current BNW Conditions of Play, to field the following teams in the 2021/22 season:

Thursday Ladies Pennant - Divisions - 1, 2, 3 & 4 (4 teams)

Saturday Open Gender Pennant - Divisions - Premier, 1, 2, 3 & 5 (5 teams)
